A one day program is planned for this summer. Call 487-1079 for details.

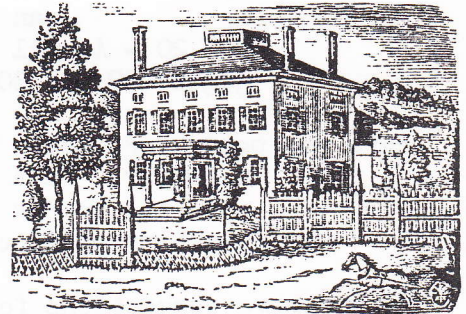
