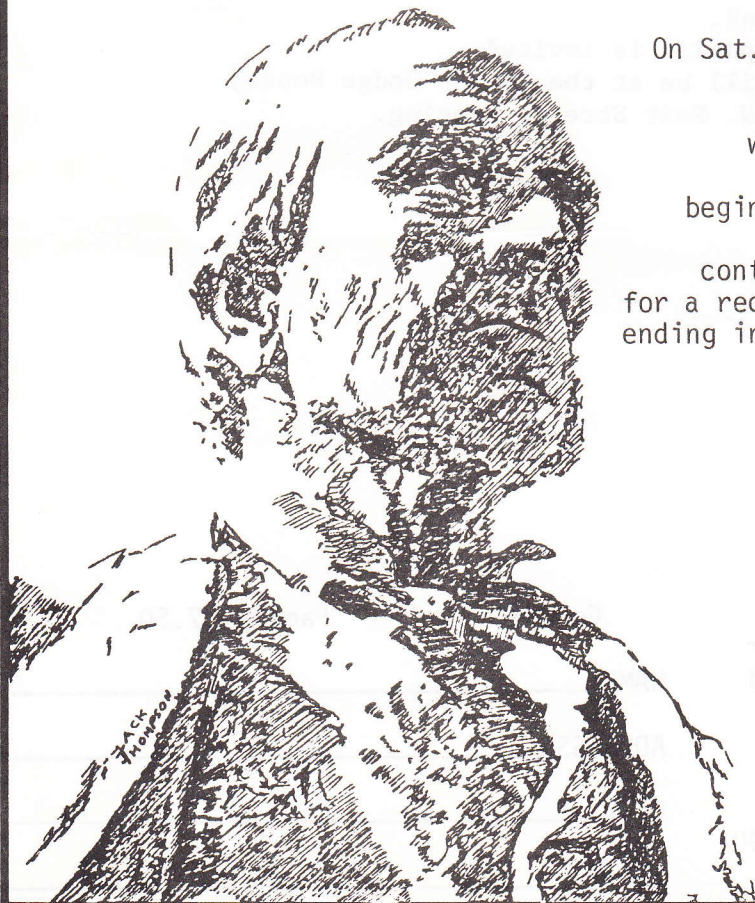
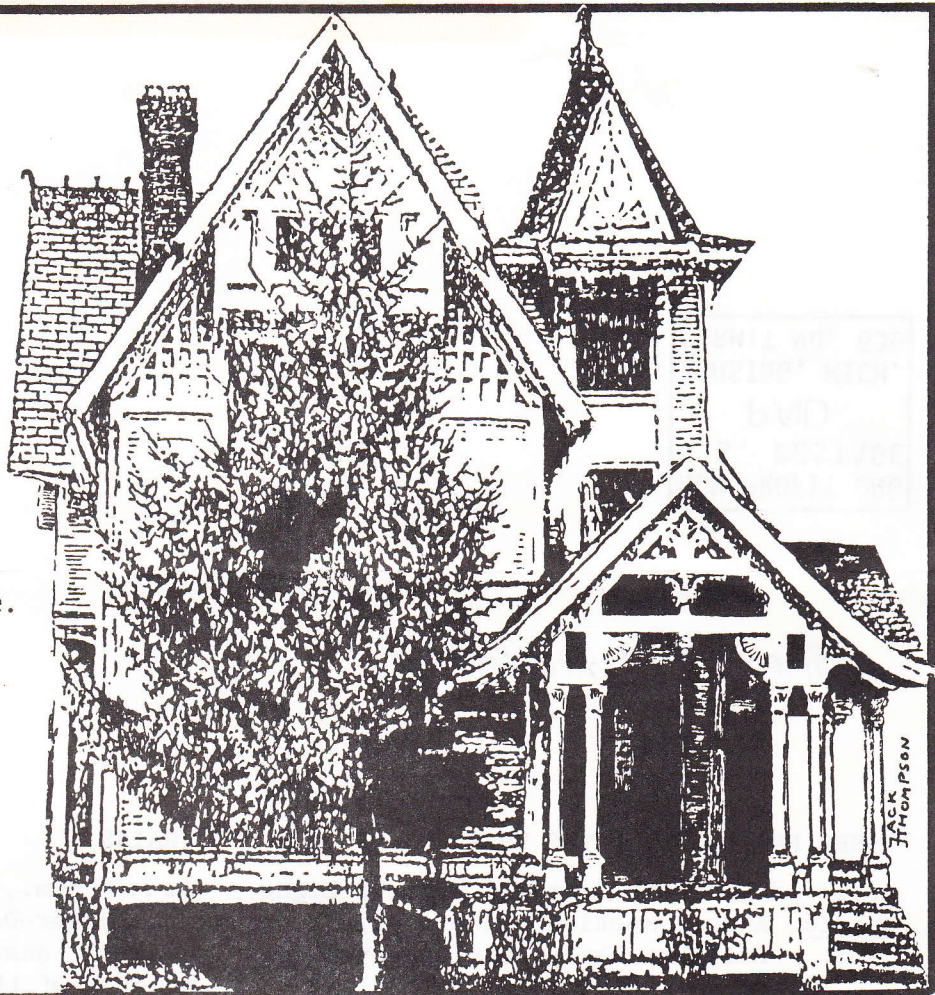

in a progressive ceremony,
beginning with a wreath-laying observance at
the governor's statue in Lansing;

for a reception and historical marker unveiling;
ending in Jackson for a second marker unveiling,
rededication of a park, and
another solemnizing of a wreath at the
governor's grave.
