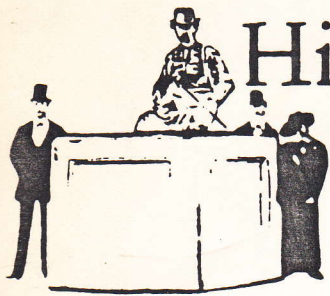

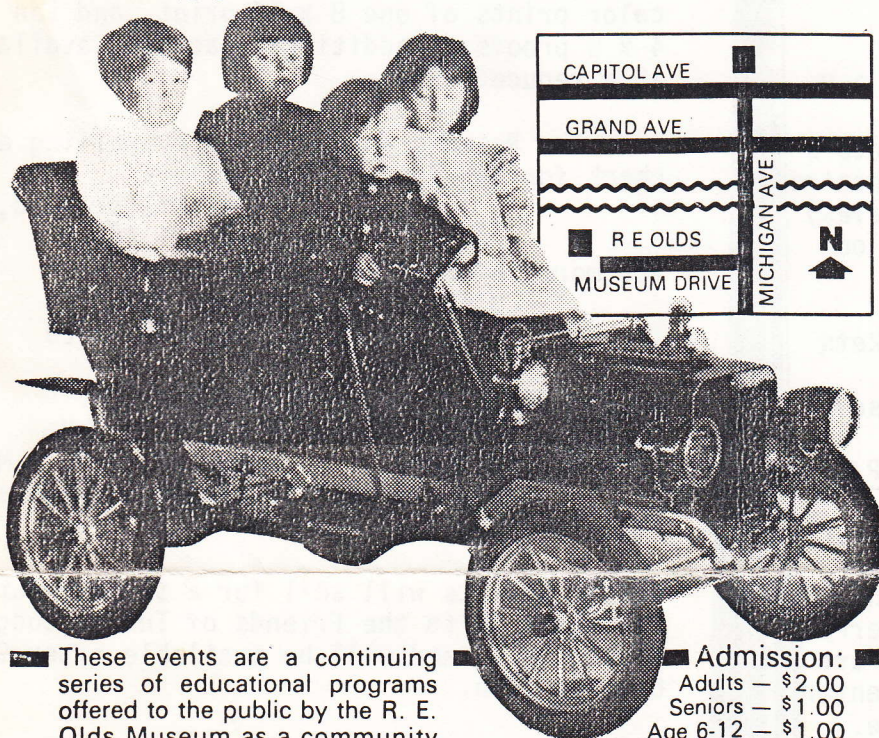

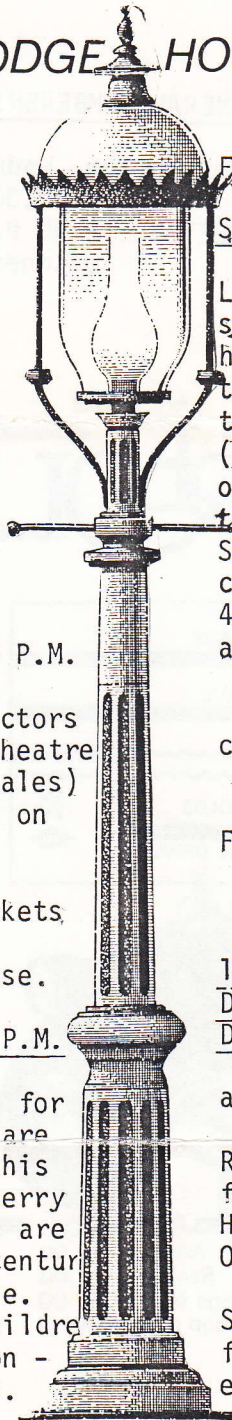
Volunteers are needed to sell tickets at the door, direct traffic, and provide information about the house.
