
A CENTENARIAN GONE.—Died in this city, at the residence of her granddaughter, Mrs. Charles Reeves, on Monday morning, Dec. 29, Lucy Karney, at the advanced age of 117 years 11 months and 27 days. Mrs. Karney was born at Freehold, Monmouth county, N. J., Jan. 2, 1762, on the farm of her master, Cornelius Van Meter. When quite a girl she was sold to Joseph Vandevere. She married at 30 years of age and had two children, a boy and a girl. When Lucy was 55 years old her master removed to Ohio and she was freed. She resided with her children until their death, in 1867, since which time she has had a home with Mr. and Mrs. Reeves. A full account of her life was published in the Republican of Dec. 7, 1877. The funeral will be held on Wednesday, Dec. 31, at the First Methodist Protestant church, at 10 o'clock A. M. The services will be conducted by Rev. Geo. Duffield, assisted by other clergymen of the city.
